The meeting will start at 10.30 each day although registration will be available from 09.30. We will have three lectures each day, two before lunch and one after lunch. We will cover a diverse range of topics including “Choosing Wisely” the NAP6 review of perioperative anaphylaxis, diagnosis and monitoring of multiple myeloma, mass spectroscopy for protein analytes, and ANCA serology. The remainder of the afternoons will be dedicated to small group workshops with topics to include Electrophoresis and immunofixation, indirect immunofluorescence for ANA/ANCA, Rheumatology, Renal disease, Allergy, Haematology, IQC and EQA, Flow cytometry and immune deficiency.
